The Criminal Justice and Legal Studies Field Observation (Legal Studies 694) is an internship opportunity that combines community engagement with classroom work. This opportunity is available every semester, including summer. Students will acquire practical experience at an agency focusing on justice-involved or at-risk individuals, those affected by crime, those seeking social/community services, or on law and legal institutions. Readings and seminars will relate field observations to the broader cultural, economic, and social implications of the justice and legal systems. This intensive, hands-on experience requires significant maturity and judgment.

Legal studies 694 fulfills the Group 6 requirement of the Criminal Justice Certificate and is a Theme 2 course for the Legal Studies Major.
